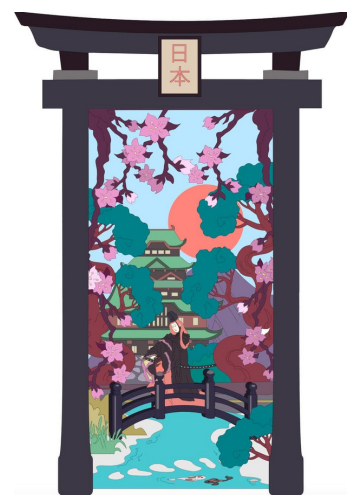
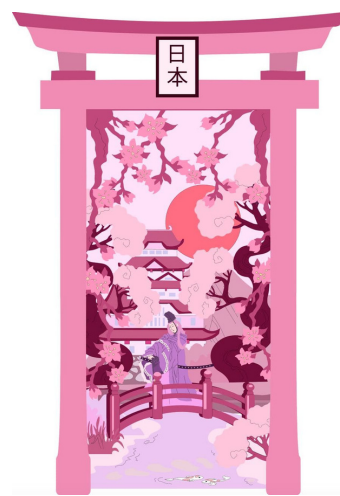
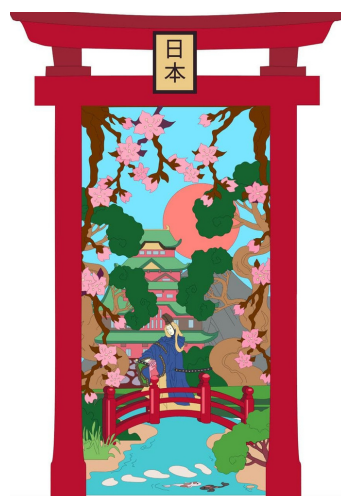
A MESSAGE TO THE CREATOR

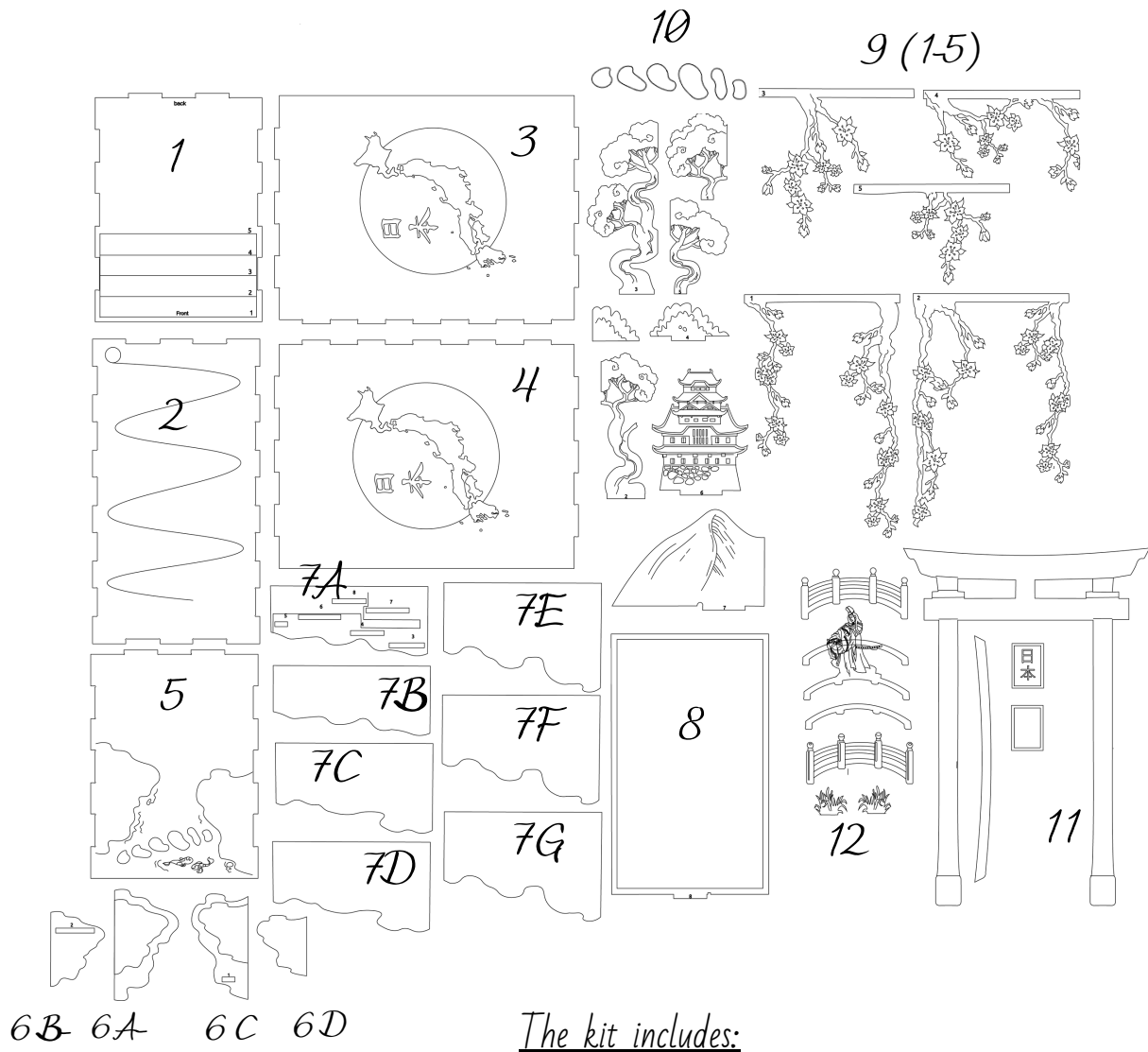


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Step-by-step instructions



For Assembly, you additionally need: wood glue, adhesive tape, *you might also need* a file (the thickness of plywood in production sometimes exceeds the declared one, so in rare cases parts may require correction).

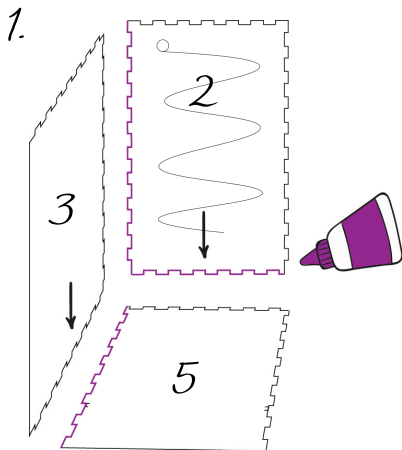


The kit includes:

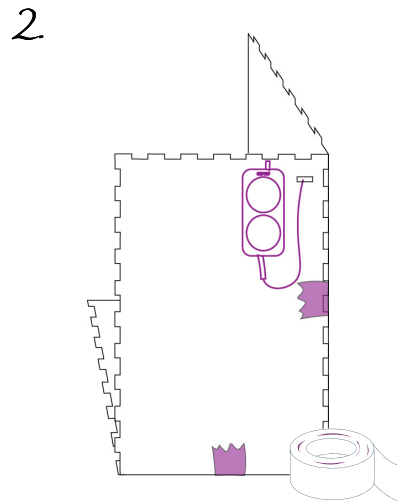

| 4. Right wall of the box | 8 Paper background frame | 12. Parts of the Bridge |

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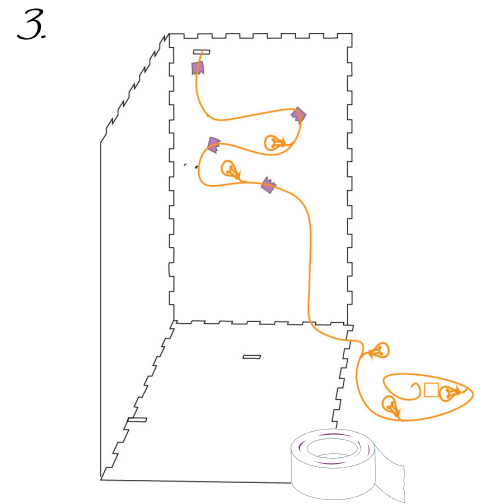
Step-by-step instructions



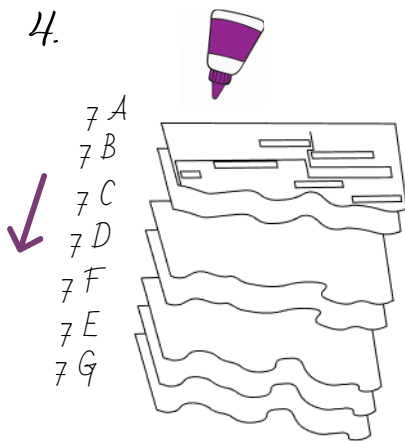
1. Glue the left wall, floor and box lid together (parts 3, 2, 5)



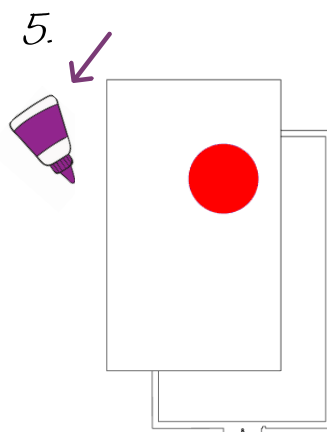
2. Secure the sides with tape so that they don't fall apart until dry.



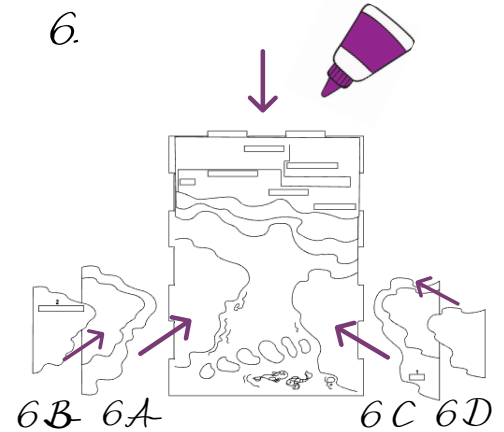
3. Push the light strip through the hole in the back wall and glue it with a transparent tape according to the engraved line. This light will illuminate the window.



4. Glue the steps together from 7A to 7G according to the picture.



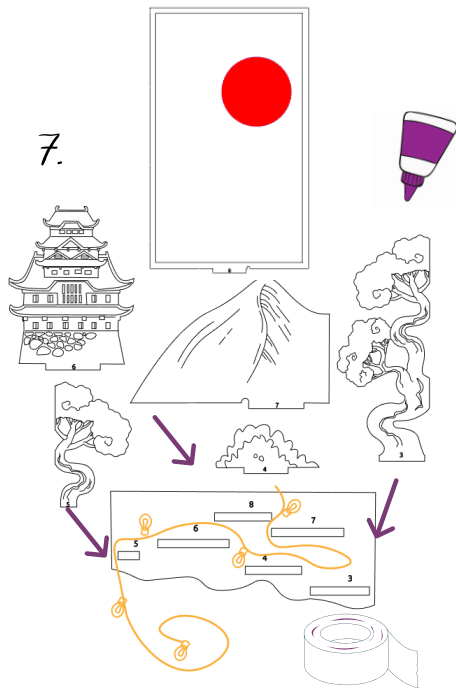
5. Glue the paper background with the sun on the frame



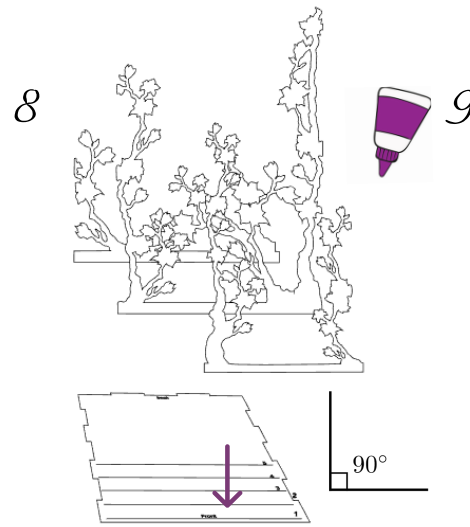
6. Glue the step block to the back wall of the box. The details of the "islands" on each other according to the engraving, and then glue them to the floor, also according to the engraving on the floor.

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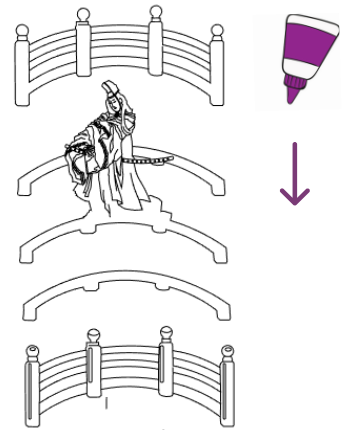
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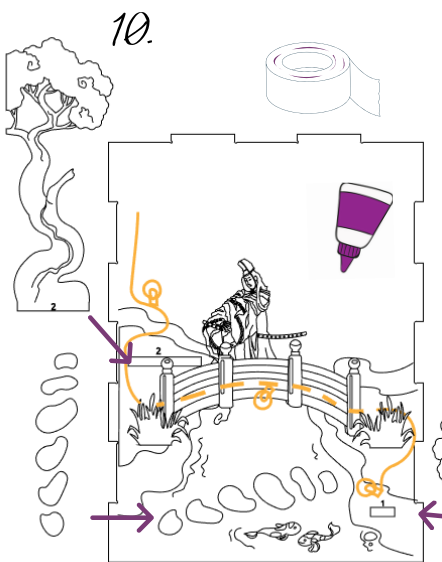
Glue the light strip to the top step according to the engraving. Then glue and insert the parts into the holes according to the numbers.



Glue all the sakura parts to the ceiling of the box at a 90-degree angle according to the engraving and numbering from 1 to 5 **IMPORTANT!** Do not go beyond the lines, otherwise you will not be able to glue the ceiling to the box later.

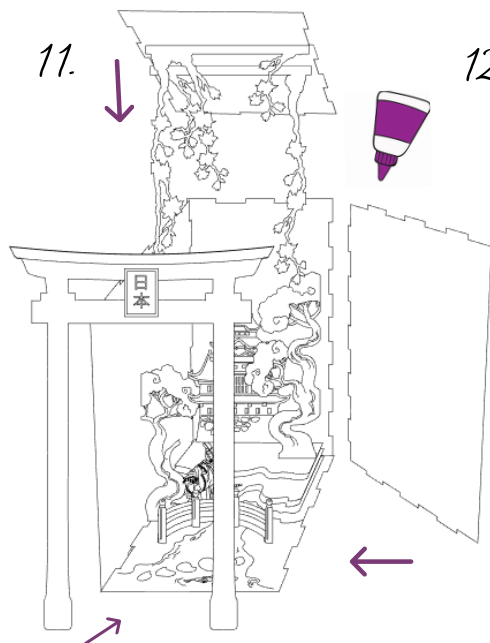


Glue the parts of the bridge so that the Japanese girl is in the middle, and the bridge can stand steadily.



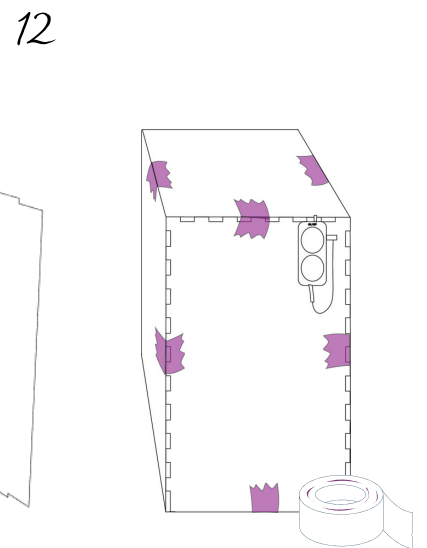
Glue the bridge to the islands. Run the rest of the light ribbon across the bridge and hide the tail behind a tree. Secure it with transparent tape. If the piece is too large, cut it off, it will not hurt the light strip.

Glue the remaining parts to the front of the stage.



Glue the side wall, then insert the ceiling with sakura, and then glue the frame.

IMPORTANT! If you accidentally broke some part, do not worry! The wood sticks together very well. Place the part on a hard surface, apply glue, connect the parts, and let it dry.



Secure the entire box and the external parts with tape while the glue dries. After a couple of hours, remove the tape and enjoy the result!
